The role

A vacancy for the position of Chaplain has occurred due to Pastor David Spike moving to a new role of Pastor of Formation and Ministry at LEVNT from the beginning of 2023. An expression of interest in a full-time Chaplain role, who may be a Pastor or Lay Person, in our College community is welcomed. This is a key role at the College and their primary focus is to have responsibility for:

- faith formation,
- leadership in the Christian Studies program, Prep – Year 12, through the Lutheran Education Australia *Christian Studies Curriculum Framework* and
- the pastoral care of staff.

Our College

Geelong Lutheran College Armstrong Creek Campus is a welcoming, lively and nurturing environment with a focus on providing a quality, Christian education for children in the Greater Geelong region. Established in 2009 and set on 11 hectares, our growing Prep to Year 12 College is in Armstrong Creek (between Geelong and Torquay) Victoria, with 830 students currently enrolled. We are expecting an enrolment of over 900 students in 2023.

Geelong Lutheran College was founded as the second Lutheran school in Geelong, growing from St John's Lutheran School and Kindergarten established in 1962 and 1963 respectively. From 1 January 2023, both schools will unite as one College, two Campuses. We have a close working relationship with the three Lutheran Congregations in Greater Geelong.

Geelong Lutheran College staff members are very committed to supporting our students and their ongoing development. Essential to our College is our relationship with God, in the context of the Gospel, where each student is valued and accepted as a child of God. We are an inclusive community.
