

Local Mission Strategic Plan 2021-2024

Since being sent in mission to share the gospel is part of the LCA's identity rather than just one of its many activities, the work of the Council for Local Mission is to see God's love in Christ coming to life so that people everywhere may know Christ and his love.

We do this by:

- Providing strategic leadership and support to nurture a growing missional culture in the Church;
- Developing strategic mission direction and establishing the overall policy environment of the Church;
- Promoting and coordinating congregational participation in local mission; and
- Overseeing and monitoring the resourcing of the mission of the Church to Australia and New Zealand. [Council for Local Mission Terms of Reference]

The Council for Local Mission (CLMission) therefore has the same strategic priorities as the Lutheran Church of Australia, namely:

Work together with Cross-Cultural Ministry to plant new multi-ethnic churches and to renew congregations in multicultural mission. This is an important part of the mission ecosystem

Promote and generate intentional gospel service and conversation in and with local communities

Care Ministries

Support congregations to develop and celebrate a local ministry of care with the aged and vulnerable in their community

Cross-Cultural Ministry

Encourage a culture of service within multicultural communities, that generates trust and opens up respectful relationships

Grow Ministries

Provide resources and workshops that promote and generate intentional intergenerational Christian service and support the discovery of aifts and talents to be used in service in local communities

Lutheran Media

Promote and support relationships with Media Missionaries and their faith communities to be equipped for mission

New and Renewing Churches

Coach missional communities and church plants to engage in intentional gospel service and conversation

Care Ministries

Liaise with LCANZ indigenous members (Aboriginal or Maori) to learn from their cultural understandings and foster a missional relationship between indigenous members and recent migrants / refugees

Grow Ministries

Promote engagement and participation with indigenous ministries and communities through its consultation, coaching, resourcing and leadership training

Lutheran Media

Partner with indigenous ministries in their media outreach
