Make an Easter display on a plate using natural items.

Do some cleaning together and talk about how we are cleansed in Christ.

Make an Easter poster together and put it up at Easter time.

Light a candle and watch it in silence for a minute or two and then pray together.

Go to church to celebrate God's great victory.

Read Luke 24:1-12 Say to each other, "Jesus is alive" and then reply "and we are alive in Him".
