## MAIN POINT

### Jesus changed water into wine.

### **SCRIPTURE FOCUS**

What Jesus did here in Cana of Galilee was the first of the signs through which he revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him. (John 2: 11)

### **ADDRESS**

**Do you know what a miracle is?** *e.g. making the blind man see, healing people with diseases, healing people so they could walk again.* 

Jesus performed lots of different and wonderful miracles in the bible.

Today's Bible reading talks about how Jesus turned water into wine. When he did this miracle everyone was amazed because this was his very first miracle. Can you imagine how wonderful it would be to have been there?

Jesus performed this special miracle so that all people would believe that he was God's Son. He didn't do miracles so that people would like him or so he could be popular. He wanted everyone to know that he was God's Son and that he came to save us all.
